CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING WINES 2023

FRANCE

Veuve Clicquot La Grande Dame Brut Rosé \$399
2008 | Champagne, France

A beautiful pink gold with light copper hues. It is full-bodied and smooth, then becomes refined with fresh aromas. The Pinot Noir's generosity resonates beautifully after a slow and long aging in the cellar. Powerful notes of red fruits (raspberry and strawberry), combined with citrus notes (blood orange, grapefruit), and finally holds a perfect balance between subtle and spicy with notes of red berries, Rooibos tea and fine leather.

Veuve Clicquot La Grande Dame Brut \$229
2008 | Champagne, France

The initial nose reveals a strong, aerial and delicate attack. Once opened, the wine has notes of dried fruits (almonds, figs, apricots), ripe white fruits (pears) and finishes on subtle toasted notes of hazelnut and praline. These pastry notes create a perfect balance with the freshness and clarity of the blend.

Veuve Clicquot Rosé \$129
2012 | Champagne, France

Coppery-orange color. Expressive aromas of strawberry and very ripe wild strawberries. A full-bodied, structured, vinous palate which stays fresh. Length and character define this champagne.

Veuve Clicquot Brut Gold Label \$99
2012 | Champagne, France

The taste is rich and ripe. The aroma offers a combination of citrus tones especially grapefruit with stone fruit – nectarine and peach. Complete and well-defined structure with fine consistency.

Veuve Clicquot Brut Reserve Cuvee \$89
NV | Champagne, France

Assembling 35% Chardonnay, 5% Meunier and 60% Pinot Noir, has a very clear, fresh, pure and intense, as well as complex nose, with brioche, biscuit and prominent chardonnay aromas. Pure, dry, straight and elegant on the palate, this is a refreshing and lifted, but also complex and expressive Brut. It also has tension, grip and a stimulating salinity in the finish. This champagne is excellent and should be served with seafood

Moët & Chandon Rose Grand Vintage \$125
2013 | Champagne, France

The 44th vintage rose in the Houses history. Fruity and spicy nose. Strawberries, raspberries, pomegranate, black pepper, chocolate, cinnamon! 44% Pinot Noir 35% Chardonnay 21% Meunier Big day Big Champagne

Moët & Chandon Brut Grand Vintage \$119
2012 | Champagne, France

Pale yellow with bright and crisp fruit flavors and yeasty notes, stone fruit flavors, apple and pear with a waft of vanilla spice. Creamy long end with toasty oak.

Moët & Chandon Imperial Nectar Grand Brut \$90
NV | Champagne, France

An elegant, softly sweet champagne with a rich fragrance of peach, white flowers and hints of clover honey on the nose, leading into a plush, full palate of core fruits and hints of toast. Perfect as a pairing for fresh fruit desserts.

Moët & Chandon Imperial Rosé Brut \$89
NV | Champagne, France

Finesse and elegant bouquet. Aromas of baked fruits, apples, peaches, and apricots. Fresh citrus, white peaches, pears, bread, brioche and buttery notes. Champagne with excellent structure, creamy texture and beautiful freshness. Finish is sophisticated with great minerality.

Aime Baron Brut Sparkling Wine Savair Fare a la Francaise Blanquette De Limoux \$32
2019 | France

Pale lemon yellow, citrus and pear on nose, light body, lightly creamy texture, small bubbles with low persistence, melon, pineapple, citrus softened by buttery notes on finish.

Veuve Du Vernay Ice Rosé \$24
NV | France

Crafted to be enjoyed over ice, this wine is fresh and delicate on the nose, revealing pronounced fruity scents and raspberry aromas with an enticing demi-sec finish. An elegant wine, well-balanced and pleasant, to be enjoyed on every occasion.

UNITED STATES

Scharffenberger Brut Excellence Méthode Traditionelle \$45
NV | Anderson Valley, California

The full malolactic style adds a vanilla cream character producing a round and full-bodied wine.

Schramsberg Blanc De Noirs \$60
2019 | California, USA

Smells just like champagne. Brioche, almond, cream, and grapefruit. Crisp, high acidity; medium body. Palate: green apple, grapefruit, apricot, almond, and toast. Creamy and mineral mouthfeel followed by a tart, dry, medium finish. Brilliant.

Gloria Ferrer Royal Cuvée Brut \$42
2016 | Los Carneros, USA

Delicate aromas of fruit and flowers. A persistent and pleasant effervescence with tastes of slightly tart apples, pear, strawberry, and toast. Just off dry. Medium bodied, tongue tickling, smooth and refreshing.

Eloise Sparkling Wine \$40
NV | California, USA

Subtle notes of honeysuckle, strawberry, and toasted brioche; an elegant combination of acidity and sweetness.

Gruet Blanc De Noir Sparkling Wine \$28
NV | New Mexico, USA

Aged for a two-year minimum, the palate is developed and shows rich complex flavors. The amazing berries aromas and the creamy texture play a leading role and create a great finesse.

Stanford Brut Governor's Cuvee \$25
NV | California, USA Split/\$8

Bright citrus notes of green apple and fresh lemon notes on the palate. Perfect starter to any evening.

The nose is fresh and floral, reminiscent of fruits of the forest. The taste is crisp, fruity, with notes of ripe, red berries. Excellent as an aperitif with appetizers, pizza, and fish

Val D'oca Prosecco Extra Dry \$32
NV | Prosecco, Italy Split/\$9

A crisp sparkling wine bursting with fragrant aromas of white stone fruits, apple and wildflowers. The harmonious taste of bright citrus fruits and a soft finish.

Famiglia Pasqua Prosecco \$32
NV | Veneto, Italy

A pale, lightly aromatic and easy-drinking sparkling wine, with a soft mousse and an off-dry feel. Gentle flavors of pear, clementine and white apple are lifted by soft acidity.

ARGENTINA

Jasmine Monet Rose Organic Vineyards \$25
NV | Argentina

In this wine, rustic, briny aromas include notes of peach and citrus fruits but are mostly disjointed and strained. An inexact palate with sugary flavors of melon and stone fruits goes nowhere on an overly simple and candied finish.

Lindemans Moscato Bin 90 \$15
NV | Southeastern Australia GL \$5

Pale in color with delightful fruity sweet flavors. Think ripe, juicy grapes and subtle musk and tropical notes.

GEWURZTRAMINER

Baron Herzog Gewurztraminer \$22
2019 | California GL \$7

Beautifully balances acidity and texture. Bursting with notes of fresh ripe apricot, tropical fruit, cinnamon, and clove.

Silverthread Gewurztraminer \$32
2021 | Finger Lakes, New York

Truly captivating wine for lovers of unique and memorable wine experiences. Exotic aromas of lychee and acacia flowers lead to a silky mouthfeel. Surprisingly light, dry and delicate, this vintage of Gewurztraminer will be highly versatile when paired with a variety of foods.

RIESLING

Twisted River Late Harvest Riesling \$18
2019 | Mosel, Germany GL \$6

Rich fruit and hints of sweet pear and melon with a sweet fruity finish.

Pacific Rim Dry Riesling \$24
2017 | Columbia Valley, California GL \$6

Pale straw in color with a bouquet of jasmine. The palate has notes of citrus, white peach, and minerals. Crisp, dry, and lush with flavors of citrus, jasmine, and minerals.

Cramele Recas Heavenly Retreat Semi Sweet Riesling \$28
2017 | Recas, Romania

White floral aromas are pure and fresh in this apple-inflected Romanian riesling. Soft on the palate, with restrained acidity and a delicate, almost lacy structure, it finishes with a hint of powdered sugar sweetness.

Forge Cellars Riesling Les Alliés \$32
2018 | Finger Lakes, New York

A hint of honeycomb melds into the background as juicy lemon peel, star fruit and gooseberry notes slowly take over. Picks up a citrus oil accent but stays zingy through the finish.

August Kessler "R" Riesling Kabinett Prädikatswein \$32
2020 | Rheingau, Germany

Pale straw color. Aromas of pineapple and green apple. Sweet palate with apple, honey, and citrus. Medium-high acidity, light body, and a tart medium-long finish.

Silverthread Good Earth Riesling Blend \$35
2021 | Finger Lakes, New York

Aromas: green apple, green herbs, along with some mango & honey. Off-dry & fruity palate. Tastes generally reflect the nose.

CHENIN BLANC

Baron Herzog Chenin Blanc Viognier \$22
2019 | Clarksburg, California GL \$7

Very nice, crisp lemon grass aroma that may suggest lots of acidity. The wine is not, however, overly acidic. Tastes of honey, apple, pear, lots of orchard fruits.

L'Ecole Yakima Valley Chen in Blanc \$32
2020 | Columbia Valley, Washington

Medium lemon color with greenish reflexes. Nose: medium intense, ripe citrus fruits, yellow flowers, with a hint of lemon honey, hay, mineral accents. In the mouth: acidic aromas of juicy citrus, ripe yellow apples, pear lemon and peaches, green grass, freshly harvested hay with garnet minerals. The wine has a pleasant acidity, medium body, little creamy texture, is light and fresh.

Indicative of its cool-climate origins, with bright acidity beneath notes of pear, apple, pineapple, apricot, nutmeg, and vanilla—all framed by a richly textured palate.

Maison Albert Signature Chardonnay
2019 | Vin De Pays D'oc, France

This Chardonnay presents a freshness and powerful aromas of citrus, with fruits, and white flowers. To serve with shellfish, fish, or white meat.

Buttonwood Grove Unoaked Chardonnay
2021 | Finger Lakes, New York

Yellow apple, peach and banana make for a fruity entrance to this unoaked Chardonnay. There's nice weight and roundness to the palate, with ample acidity to back it up.

L'ecole No. 41 Chardonnay
2018 | Columbia Valley, Washington

This classic Chardonnay offers an inviting mix of baked apple, asian pear, and stone. With lemon oil and brioche on the mid-palate, this wine lively builds to a long mineral finish.

Morgan Highland Chardonnay
2019 | Santa Lucia Highlands, Monterey, Central Coast, California

Focused and elegant, the aromas feature pear, clove, green apple, and caramel. On the palate, a light touch of meyer lemon, graham cracker, and nutmeg.

Lola Chardonnay
2021 | Sonoma County, California

This Chardonnay is packed with citrus, tropical fruits, flowers, and a touch of baking spices and toast. A round finish with beautifully balanced refreshing acidity.

Taken Chardonnay
2019 | Napa Valley, California

A beautiful nose of spice, citrus and lemon blossom. On the palate, Asian pear, grapefruit and Gravenstein apple are rounded out with hints of butterscotch and walnut. The mouthfeel is juicy, though not too heavy, with an uplifting, refreshing, crisp finish.

Orin-Swift Mannequin Chardonnay
2021 | California, USA

Yellow gold. Lightly sweet, med-low acid, medium bitter. Very rich. Tastes like bananas, vanilla, oak, and pineapple. Buttery.

Laird Family Estate Cold Creek Ranch Chardonnay
2015 | Los Carneros, Napa Valley, California

Golden straw in color, the wine has aromatics of tropical fruits, sweet nectarine, melon, and vanilla. On the palate, jasmine, citrus, and ripe Fuji apple are complemented by a creamy mouthfeel and hints of lemon curd.

Patricia Green Cellars Sauvignon Blanc

The strength of the aromatics resounds in the glass with tropical notes at the entry giving way to apples with extremely crisp acidity on the finish. The wine is bright and fresh but retains an enormous amount of texture and richness without being heavy

Hall Sauvignon Blanc
2018 | Napa Valley, California

Great intensity on the nose with gooseberry, fresh cut grass, juicy mango, lemon rind, and grapefruit. This wine is dry with crisp acidity and a palate that unveils layers of pineapple, lemon, lime, minerality, and rich creaminess.

2017 | Napa Valley, California

Bursting with aromas of citrus blossom, lemon zest and fresh cut pineapple, underscored with a note of dried summer grass. Crisp acidity on the palate is complimented with notes of orange peel and minerality.

Medium-high body. Nice bright acidity. Dry. Fruit and floral on the nose: apple, peach, honey, orange/citrus, and flowers. Palate is bright sour cherry, butter, with vegetable mineralogy.

Baron Philippe De Rothschild
2018 | Mouton Cadet Bordeaux Blanc – Bordeaux, France

A wine that uses the white Bordeaux Trinity of Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon and Muscadelle, this a ripe passionfruit and peachy character, with a little hint of toast in the background. On the palate this is full and quite opulent, with plenty of peach and ripe, juicy pear fruit.

Domaine Gueguen Bourgogne Rosé
2019 | Bourgogne, France

Its intriguing aromas blend watermelon and red berries with subtle wildflowers and a hint of almonds. On the palate it's dry and crisp, with little or no sweetness, and gentle but perceptible acidity to give it structure.

Jean Claude Poisson Pouilly Fuisse Chardonnay
2015 | Burgundy, France

Its young robe is brilliant, glittering with a pale, yellow color with green tints. Its open, powerful, and intense nose offers a great aromatic and complex palate mixing toffee, vanilla, and exotic fruit.

Domaine Serge Laporte Sancerre Les Boursicottes
2016 | Sancerre, France

Blood orange and seaside minerality on the nose; white apricot and lemon zest flavor the crisp midrange; pine, beach grass and a hint of grapefruit in the finish.

Barton & Guestier Sancerre
2017 | Sancerre, France

Bright pale straw yellow. Expressive nose mixing intense aromas of flowers (acacia), white berries and exotic fruits (pineapple) with a touch of citrus (grapefruit). Fresh and lively attack evolving on a long mineral finish.

Very fresh citrusy Bordeaux Blanc from the Village of Cantois near the Garonne. Clear lemon yellow. Medium bodied, dry, high acidity, soft mouthfeel, bright ripe white grapefruit, passion fruit, mango and lemon zest.

Doña Paula Smoked Red Blend 2018 | Mendoza, Argentina

This wine is aged using customized barrels smoked with a unique process that gives them similar aromas found in a traditional Argentinean barbecue (asado). Intense violet colored wine, with very complex aromas of red fruit jam, spices, vanilla, and a delicate smokiness. On the palate it stands out for its sweet, velvety tannins.

Peterson Shameless Red Blend NV | Dry Creek Valley- California

Aromatics of forest floor and dark red fruit—cherry and cranberry—lead into a soft, round mouth filled with a dark cherry core against a backdrop of spicy cedar with just a touch of white floral. Notes of blackberry and traces of eucalyptus and savory herbs appear as the wine opens. Creamy oak rounds out the finish as the flavors linger.

Z. Alexander Brown Uncaged Red Blend 2019 | North Coast, California

Dark garnet in the glass, dense layers of jammy fruit, black cherry and toasted oak leave a lasting impression leading to a robust yet smooth finish.

Silverthread Good Earth Red Wine 2021 | Finger Lakes, New York
